In the last session of Congress Rep. Dingell introduced the "Restoring Confidence in Our Democracy Act", a bill to amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 " to reassert the authority of Congress to restrict spending by corporations and labor organizations on campaigns for elections for Federal office."

Co-sponsors included Representatives John Conyers, Chris Van Hollen, Keith Ellison, Donna Edwards, and Barney Frank. It was also endorsed by Common Cause and the United Auto Workers union.

This legislation will be re-introduced into the current session of Congress. Congressman Dingell and the panel members will address the issues of Citizens United and this legislation at this public forum.
